MINNESOTA VOLLEYBALL ASSOCIATION, LLC PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS ARE PROHIBITED:

Before or during event: Individual disqualified immediately (if person is a junior she/he will be sent home as soon as possible and parent or guardian notified). The individual will be declared ineligible for MVA membership for one calendar year starting from the date of the infraction.

After event concludes: Individual will be declared ineligible for MVA membership for one year starting from the date of the infraction.

SECOND INFRACTION

Individual disqualified immediately (if person is a junior she/he will be sent home as soon as possible and parent or guardian notified). The individual will be declared ineligible for MVA membership for two years starting from the date of the infraction.

THIRD INFRACTION

Individual will be immediately declared ineligible for MVA membership for the remainder of his/her lifetime.
